ReUnite wristbands, pin badges and fobs are devices available from Wakefield Hospice for vulnerable people who may be disorientated, distressed and lost.

The ReUnite devices use Near Field Communication (NFC) technology installed in most mobile phones to read a tiny microchip inside the device (the same way a phone can read a QR code).

When the ReUnite device is scanned, it will display the vulnerable person's first name and up to two emergency contact numbers.

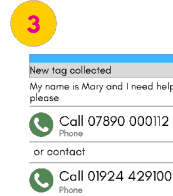
ReUnite devices - how do they work?



The ReUnite devices have a microchip that can transfer information to a NFC enabled mobile phone



The device is set up by using a NFC tag writer app on a mobile phone (details will be provided to all users)



Simply tap the back of the phone on the ReUnite logo to display the message on your phone.
